The *Homeland Security Advisory System* will provide a comprehensive and effective means to disseminate information regarding the risk of terrorist attacks to Federal, State, and local authorities and to the American people. As part of a series of initiatives to improve coordination and communication among all levels of government and the American public in the fight against terrorism, President Bush signed *Homeland Security Presidential Directive 3*, creating the *Homeland Security Advisory System* (HSAS). The advisory system will be the foundation for building a comprehensive and effective communications structure for the dissemination of information regarding the risk of terrorist attacks to all levels of government and the American people. The question now is, "How do you use this great system" and "What should we do with this system in preparing our schools?"
